This includes inappropriate behaviour towards fellow staff members as well as customers, clients or suppliers.

### **What is bullying?**

Workplace bullying is repeated and unreasonable behaviour directed towards a worker or group of workers that can be physical, verbal or social (ie: excluding or isolating someone or spreading rumours).

Repeated behaviour is persistent and can involve a range of actions.

Unreasonable behaviours are actions that a reasonable person wouldn't do in the same circumstances. Including victimising, humiliating, intimidating or threatening a person.

A single incident of unreasonable behaviour isn't considered workplace bullying.

### **What is harassment?**

General harassment could include any unwanted and unjustified behaviour which another person find offensive or humiliating and it has a negative effect on the person receiving the behaviour. Harassment can be in the form of a one off event.

Types of harassment include sexual, racial and discrimination.

### **What is discrimination?**

Discrimination is unjust or prejudicial treatment of different categories of people and are typically (but not limited to) in relation to race, age or gender.


### **Responsibilities**
